

Guidline – Dining table and Chair set 1 / 24 scale

What you need to do

1. Get your stuff



2. Print the PDF template

 You can print out the file on A4 paper.

Using SVG / DXF file for your cutting machine

** The total size of template is 30x30 centimetre*

** If you use cutting machine to die cut and score, You can pass Step 3,4 Remember after you import the file in your design space, you have to change the dash lines to be a scoring mode*

**If your cutting machine don't have a scoring option, Please delete the dash lines before cutting. Then continue to step 4.*

3. Cut out along the solid line

The scissors or knife :

I personally prefer to use knife to cut out along a black lines around their edges. I also use a metal ruler when I cut the part of straight lines.

4. Score along the fold lines

I prefer the inkless pen to score along the dash lines but you can use other things such as a ruler or the back of your knife.

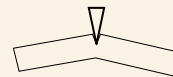

Tips for Assembly

- How to make sharp folds :

There are different tricks. I use a metal ruler place along the fold line. Then I use a knife to gently and evenly slice the top 1/3 of the paper.



- Use a **toothpick** to apply the glue where the assembly is to be made.

- Use **tweezers** when picking up and attaching small parts. Tweezers are useful for holding parts that need to be glued while you wait for them to dry.
